A) Introduction:

In line with the implementation of the provisions of the statute and regulations of the executive committee as well as the approvals of CINVU General Assemblies, and the executive committee, and in order to improve and make the activities of network members as efficient as possible, this regulation is for the purpose of using all the potential and actual capacities of educational and research, social culture, economic cooperation based on the commercialization of knowledge and knowledge-based products, as well as using the achievements of member countries and universities, it has been developed to achieve the goals of CINVU and approved in the third general assembly on May 11-12, 2022 and after the necessary amendments, it was informed to the members on October 24, 2022.

B) Objectives:

The goals that CINVU pursues in the implementation of this regulation is the interaction between CINVU members with the least executive processes, which are:

- 1- Quantitative and qualitative expansion of the field of activities of universities and help in the development of virtual education;
- 2- Dynamic increase in the specialized fields of professors, researchers, knowledge-based companies and other educational and research centers;
- 3- Optimum use of educational and research facilities and services available in universities;
- 4- Development of joint activities in educational, research, cultural and social fields and commercialization;
- 5- Creating an exchange in terms of human resources capacities and public resources of the member universities within the framework of the rules and regulations of the statutes and regulations of the academic centers of the countries members;
- 6- Establishing consortia and inter-university core organizations to synergize existing capacities and activate potential capacities that have not been activated so far;
- 7- Reducing the cost of studying in higher education courses at different levels;
- 8- The possibility of using potential scientific and practical capacities in specific areas and disciplines for students in choosing professors and course content from member universities by eliminating redundant processes of admission and evaluation for education;

9- The possibility of obtaining supplementary educational capacities as supplementary or secondary courses for students by passing in the main courses of their choice in secondary fields to the necessary capabilities.

C) Definitions of the Terms Used in the Regulations:

In order to plan and direct the current activities as best as possible, determine the duties, scope of work and create a common language with other real and legal stakeholders, the levels were determined as follows:

1- **OIC:** The Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) which consists of 57 Islamic countries, which also has an observer member.

2- **COMSTECH:** Refers to the Ministerial Standing Committee on Scientific and Technological Cooperation of the OIC.

3- **CINVU:** the COMSTECH Inter-Islamic Network on Virtual Universities for short (CINVU), which is in charge of virtual education activities in the Islamic world based on the approved tasks and programs.

4- **Secretary General:** the Secretary General of the CINVU, who is the head of the strategic council and specialized committees, and is responsible for the implementation of CINVU affairs.

5- **Executive Committee:** There are nine members of the CINVU Executive Committee approved in 2019.

6- **Strategic Council:** A council that, in order to institutionalize the culture of participation and the use of microgroups in order to fulfill CINVU's mission and with the aim of increasing the effectiveness, efficiency and creating coherence and integrity in the programs, consists of the general secretary, the secretaries of the specialized committees and the deputy and The head of the permanent secretariat of CINVU has been formed, and in addition to the people mentioned, other real and legal members will also be in that council at the discretion of the secretary general.

7- **Specialized Committees:** CINVU's strategic council committees are responsible for reviewing and approving network programs in the process of educational, research, cultural, social, student cooperation, commercialization of knowledge, issuance of licenses and and other important issues that have a decisive role.

8- Student: Is a substantive or legal person who is a member of Islamic (permanent) or non-Islamic (observer) countries with scientific abilities and has a request to attend training courses that meet the academic level and academic rank. According to the application, the course will be decided according to the executive instructions.

9- Professor: Is a substantive or legal person who is a member of Islamic (permanent) or non-Islamic (observer) countries with scientific, professional and expert qualifications and is responsible for organizing and compiling educational courses.

10- Institutions: Legal entities approved by competent scientific, educational, and technological authorities and a member of Islamic (permanent) or non-Islamic (observer) countries, which include universities, research institutes, organizations and parks. Science and technology institutions, scientific associations and other institutions and educational, research and technology centers that have the necessary qualifications and relevant licenses to hold courses according to the licenses, instructions and regulations of the country of origin.

Note: For each notification, it is mandatory to hold the course in accordance with the cooperation agreement and its relevant documents.

11- Training course: The desired training course is based on the plans and policies of the network in 5 levels:

11-1- General education course: In order to increase the level of awareness, scientific, educational, and technological foundations of public entities of member and non-member countries, it is held in the form of media and the use of educational technologies, both online and offline which can be the time of holding a short-term course and is in line with the realization of the justice of education in electronic form for the general Muslims;

11-2- Vocational-skill training course: To increase the level of awareness and scientific, educational and technological foundation of volunteers, participate in courses to acquire professional skills in various fields (technical and engineering, basic sciences) humanitarian, medicine, art, language);

11-3- Short-term specialized training courses: to increase the level of knowledge and scientific, educational and technological foundation of candidates participating in courses to obtain scientific promotion in one of the sub-branches of different educational fields with the basic level of education with participation One of the institutions of member countries approved by CINUV and all the required services and affairs are under the responsibility and supervision of the organizing institutions and CINUV, and the certificate issued jointly and within the scope of the scientific capacity and credit defined in the course;

11-4- **Special training courses:** in order to improve the ability and scientific, educational and technological foundation of the candidates to participate in the courses that its common application in various educational fields and at the level of master's degree, doctorate is interdisciplinary, and in terms of holding conditions, it is in accordance with row 11-3;

11-5- **Cross-sectioned specialized training courses:** these courses are aimed at improving the scientific and technological foundation of the company's candidates in various courses in order to obtain scientific promotion in different fields according to the training course and the level of education with the participation of higher education institutions. The license is issued by the Ministry of Higher Education of the member countries and all required services and affairs are under the responsibility and supervision of the organizing center and CINVU, and the educational certificates issued jointly (network and institutions).

12- **Virtual and combined education:** Virtual education means holding online or offline training courses which is realized by using media infrastructure to carry out educational activities, which in some cases is done in a combined form (virtual and face-to-face).

13- **Academic degree:** the official academic degree of the course, which is obtained in each of the courses after attending, evaluating, obtaining the necessary qualifications and obtaining success in passing the degree course is issued to candidates. (the degree can be in physical or digital form).

14- **Certificate:** Official certificate of the course, which in each of the courses after attending, evaluating, obtaining the necessary qualifications and obtaining success in passing the course except for the courses, (which the certificate can be in the form of be it physical or digital), is issued to the candidates.

15- **Course fee:** It is the amount that the candidate must pay in cash or in installments according to the notices announced for holding the course and its manner and conditions.

16- **Percentage of participation:** for long-term planning and encouragement for stakeholders who strive to create different courses or realize CINVU's income sources according to Article 14 of the Constitution that after receiving it, they will share in the amount brought.

17- **The content of educational management:** all the documents that are based on the rules of conducting the course in written or digital form are the basis for candidates to get the necessary training in the courses.

18- **Call:** comprehensive information to CINVU members to attract volunteers and applicants to participate in the courses which can be done through the site, media, information systems or portal (CINVU portal).

19- **Identifier:** the line of checks that is given to real and legal members after confirming their qualifications and authentication for activities based on the organizational structure and access level in order to use the relevant services.

20- **CINVU comprehensive system:** a set of services defined by a person, whether a professor, volunteer, or other legal and real person, to use it, you must follow the instructions in it regarding authentication and registration of your information and request the desired type of service and after confirmation, it will be possible to use the access level defined in the system.

21- **Databases:** It is a data center or database which can be centralized or decentralized so that after carrying out and realizing the procedures foreseen in paragraph 20, it is possible for the applicants to use the capacity of the databases.

22- **Language:** Based on the approvals of the network, the official language for holding courses and other activities is English, Arabic, and French, other common and native languages of the countries such as Farsi, Urdu, Malay, Turkish, Spanish, etc. are not hindered for the activities.

23- **Validation of documents and certificates issued by CINVU members:** according to the requirements of the verification of documents and certificates issued based on CINVU's inquiry from the competent centers for the validity of the issued documents and certificates, the answers have been given. It is a confirmation from CINVU which is determined in the form of a code and with instructions issued by CINVU information technology and is done with the aim of speeding up the process of university inquiries.

24- **Virtual educational tour:** Participating in a part of the training course operations as needed to use scientific capabilities and experiences in the form of a tour, in the centers that the course organizer determines, in order to participate and pass the course syllabus in a scientific manner and passed an opinion.

25- **Competency test:** It is a test that the candidate takes for the part of his capabilities in the desired field with scientific and educational reserves who is in the desired field by participating in the exam, evaluates his qualifications that the documents issued in this field are in accordance with the instructions issued for participating in the exam and in order to facilitate the admission processes of universities, it is done with the management of CINVU and the relevant committee.

Note: Some joint courses between CINVU and other members can be held independently according to the priorities, which will only have the validity of a certificate and not a degree, which is approved as a valid course.

26- **Representative office or branch:** a center that, based on the approvals and instructions issued by CINVU, has delegated authority to carry out the actions of various affairs, on behalf of

the main center in one of the places or centers located in another geographical location (overseas, within the border) is responsible.

27- **Legal personality:** it is the organizations that, based on the approvals and regulations and current laws in member and non-member countries, have the qualifications to do work in different formats, including private, public, cooperative, institute, knowledge companies. Foundations, companies, etc. have been determined and formed according to the laws of each country and international laws, which CINVU cooperates with to advance affairs.

28- **Agreement and contract:** creating a legal relationship between the parties based on the limits of determined in it, work relationships, accrued rights, obligations and the manner of doing things are determined in a certain period and conditions.

29- **Power of attorney:** a substantive or legal person who, according to the duties defined and delegated based on the creation decrees and legal decrees, has the necessary powers to carry out the matters listed in paragraph 28, and any action and its effects have a legal burden.

30- **Brokerage:** It means doing things that according to paragraph 28 of the substantive or legal person duties of a specific activity which is responsible for doing things according to specific conditions and following rules and regulations and laws.

31- **Student recruitment and exchange:** creating the necessary capacities to benefit from the scientific and technological opportunities of interest and needs of the students of member centers and universities in various fields in the training courses of paragraph 11 and other cases need.

32- **Recruiting and exchange of professors:** creating the necessary capacities to benefit from the scientific and technological opportunities of the interest and needs of the professors of member centers and universities in various fields in the training courses of paragraph 11 and other cases need.

33- **Integration of documents and certificates:** creating a common portal for all graduates in different educational levels and training courses in paragraph 11 to inform and find out all members about the number of graduates and remove Evaluation process for student recruitment and verification of documents and certificates among all members whose authenticity has been confirmed by CINVU.

34- **Courses and resources:** All content and texts approved by universities, which are presented to students by professors.

35- CINVU educational centers: educational centers under the supervision of CINVU, such as the International Language Center, the International Center for Short-Term Education and other required centers that were established independently in line with the goals and missions related to electronic educational justice and cultivates capable human resources in the management of virtual education in the Islamic world, and its certificates are approved by all CINVU members.

Note: CINVU can establish a large international virtual university as a model university in the world, especially in the Islamic world, with the participation of its members, and its processes will be announced.

36- Educational cooperation: joint educational activities between members at all levels for students, professors, researchers, faculty members, etc. are referred to in virtual and combined form with the detailed description of the second part of the regulations.

37- Research cooperation: joint research activities between members at all levels for students, professors, researchers and faculty members, etc., are referred to in virtual and combined form with the detailed description of the third part of the regulations.

38- Cultural, Quranic, social and student cooperation: to joint cultural, Quranic, social and student activities between members at all levels for students, professors, researchers and faculty members, especially scientists and Quranic reciters in virtual and combined form with description The fourth part of the regulation is detailed.

39- Cooperation in the commercialization of knowledge, technology and knowledge-based products: to joint knowledge-based and technological activities between members at all levels for students, professors, researchers and faculty members, etc, which result in the creation of scientific value and become economic in the Islamic world, it is said with a detailed description of the fifth part of the regulations.

40- International accreditation: refers to all accreditations, including institutions and centers, professors, students, researchers, faculty members, certificates, degrees and other related matters which is done by CINVU to the mentioned cases.

Introduction:

Educational cooperation is possible in different formats between members, which will be mentioned separately according to the type of cooperation;

The main goal of this cooperation is to identify the capacities of the members, synergize and carry out joint educational projects in a virtual and combined manner so that the level of education increases significantly and is effective in realizing educational justice in an intelligent manner in the Islamic world.

A) Conducting Training Courses:

1- In the implementation of the goals set in the training courses in the form of the following 5 courses:

- Short-term courses;
- Cross-sectional courses;
- General courses;
- Professional skill training courses;
- Special courses.

All the member institutions (meaning the member institutions, paragraph number 10 of part C in the first part of the regulations) upload their courses on the network portal based on their approved educational programs and provides the possibility of benefiting from this type of education for students and applicants according to the educational calendar they provide and doing these trainings can be done in groups and organizations or individually and based on tuition/syllabus instructions and other things that are necessary to pass the course or training package, are done through registration in the network portal.

2- Academic degrees or relevant certificates are issued after the completion and approval of the courses individually or jointly with the approval of the permanent secretariat of the network; in other words, the above certificate and documents are issued with the digital confirmation or physical signatures, and for its validation, it is based on the identification code that can be traced in the CINVU comprehensive inquiry system.

3- All executive matters of educational cooperation are carried out under the permanent supervision of the educational committee and the permanent secretariat of CINVU.

4- The CINVU educational committee is responsible for the following duties:

1-4- Evaluation of the current status of virtual education in the Islamic world and studies regarding achieving the desired status of this field;

2-4- Investigating, analyzing and diagnosing the processes of doing work and providing suggestions to improve the efficiency of education and achieve the desired state of education in the Islamic world;

3-4- Preparation and compilation of policies, suitable solutions and practical methods in order to improve the performance and increase the quality of trainings;

4-4- Identifying countries and universities that do not benefit from higher education and helping to strengthen them;

4-5- Reviewing and suggesting completion and modification of instructions, technical specifications, rules and standards used in the field of education;

6-4- Coordinating and supporting to hold joint courses at the 5 levels mentioned among the members and verifying the documents and certificates;

4-7- Managing the issuance of educational licenses for all applicants of related educational institutions and centers;

8-4- Standardization, evaluation, validation and accreditation to the nature of institutions and educational centers and the certificates and documents related to them;

4-9- Ranking of related educational institutions and centers in the Islamic world;

4-10- Cooperation in the exchange of students, professors, fields, resources and other matters related to integrated educational management in the Islamic world;

4-11- Maximum use of the capacity of member and non-member institutions, knowledge-based companies and other related institutions to advance programs;

4-12- Coordination with the permanent secretariat of the network for cooperation and implementation of affairs.

5- The permanent secretariat of CINUV is responsible for the following duties:

5-1- Inviting members to attend meetings;

5-2- Preparing agendas and minutes of council meetings;

3-5- Compilation and amendment of internal regulations;

5-4- Creating continuous and dynamic communication with the committees and following up on council approvals;

5-5- Sending performance reports of specialized committees to the Council;

5-6- Preparation and presentation of comprehensive reports on the progress of implementation of plans and programs to relevant authorities.

6- Considering the standardization and ranking of member universities and their periodic evaluation in terms of ranking, member institutions, they should provide the latest evaluations and capabilities of the network members in the field of education to the secretary of the CINVU Education Committee to introduce and utilize all the capacities and opportunities for specific and general audiences in order to develop and balance university educational capacities.

7- In order to facilitate the cooperation process, courses that have the ability to provide special content in terms of syllabi, given that they are provided through the top professors of the member universities, students can get their degree by passing this course aggregately.

8- Member institutions, a list of capable international professors to the CINVU Education Committee through correspondence, they offer to define international professor IDs for them to provide different trainings in the authentic platforms introduced by CINVU.

9- Students of the member institutions can apply for an international student ID through the institutions in order to take advantage of the capacity to take courses, participate in training courses, support strategic and knowledge-based projects, opportunities Studies, student services and other matters related to students' affairs should be used with the cooperation of all committees.

10- The international validity of CINVU certificates and documents is applicable to all legal and substantive persons according to the standards of the Education Committee which was done by the Secretary General of CINVU before the approval of this regulation, and after the approval of this regulation, the CINVU Education Committee will be responsible for this and the validity of its continuous courses is confirmed for all member institutions and the Ministry of Higher Education of the countries and the courses will be valid with the approval of the head of the institutions and the education committee the main goal of the accreditation process is to reduce bureaucracy to facilitate cooperation between member institutions.

11- The language of conducting the courses is Arabic, English, French and other native languages of countries that can be presented at international levels.

12- The amount of course fees, teaching fees, added value is defined by the presenters based on the type of course, and according to CINVU's agreement with the presenters, the income of each presenter is determined and deposited;

The related income for CINVU will be spent for organizational purposes such as salaries of colleagues, committees and other activists associated with CINVU are part of those expenses and supporting projects, infrastructure development and activities and other programs, including expenses, are these revenues.

13- Medical training courses are held in coordination with academicians and educational centers licensed by the diagnostic authority in this field.

14- Educations related to the field of prevention, health and lifestyle are possible with leading educational institutions and centers that have the necessary standards and relevant licenses.

15- International and national institutions make payments through the CINVU portal that these payments include membership fees, tuition fees, educational services, research, technology and other resources allowed in CINVU's statutes.

16- If the members agree, valid digital currencies can be the basis of payment for CINVU, which will be informed in the form of official announcements.

17- Virtual and combined education infrastructure provided by CINVU has high standards which fully ensures the transfer of knowledge for the training applicant and provides a more complete service than face-to-face training in some cases.

B) Recruitment & Exchange of Student:

1- Due to the fact that in virtual education, there are many different capacities in terms of the possibility of accessing different areas and disciplines for applicants of higher education and other educational courses therefore, according to this regulation, it will be possible to exchange students in a virtual and combined form with the approvals announced by the member institutions.

2- The member institutions, in the CINVU comprehensive system, enter the necessary information provided by the CINVU education committee, according to the framework established in the system, in order to take necessary measures regarding the student exchange processes between the members.

3- According to the headings presented in the languages mentioned in paragraph 11 of part A of the second part of this regulation, students can choose their field, course, professor and other services provided by the members in each of the member institutions of the network through the CINVU comprehensive system that system intelligently directs the applicants to the member collections.

4- All courses, fields and professors in CINVU are approved by all members who accepted this regulation and to admit students in their interests, after CINVU approval, they will not create any obstacles to continue their studies.

5- Student exchange takes place at all educational levels, especially Academic and Degree levels, and there is also the possibility of guest and transfer.

6- CINVU receives a percentage of related tuition fees from each student for CINVU's expenses for the services it provides for the exchange of students between members that the percentage of which is agreed upon for services and interaction with each university.

Note: If the annual membership fee is paid regularly by the member institutions, the percentage of receiving services will be significantly reduced and in some cases will reach zero.

7- According to the needs of students regarding obtaining the necessary information, each institution is obliged to prepare a clip of its introduction in international languages and CINVU will upload it to each institution's introduction file on www.cinvu.net.

8- Students who study in the structure of virtual education and in case of need, it is necessary to pass a part of the course in person (combined education), to travel to the member countries, all matters related to residence are provided by the destination countries.

9- Obtaining the CINVU International ID is mandatory for all students of member institutions, and the process of obtaining this ID will be done in cooperation with the institutions and the CINVU Education Committee.

10- The classification of branches of humanities, basic sciences, technical and engineering, medicine and interdisciplinary topics in the process of recruitment and exchange in postgraduate education is done according to the regulations of the universities.

11- Financial matters including tuition fees, inquiries and other requirements can be accessed in the CINVU comprehensive system and the relevant section.

12- Obtaining permits to recruit and exchange students virtually and holding eligibility verification tests for entry into bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees will be done through

institutions and with the support of CINVU and the Ministry of Higher Education of the countries, with the approval of CINVU and member institutions, will proceed to admit students.

C) Recruitment & Exchange of Professors:

1- Using the scientific capacities of the professors of the member institutions, according to this regulation, in the form of different courses in the form of visiting, right-teaching, associate, scientific or faculty members, based on the university rank according to the defined possibility identifier. will be acceptable that it is necessary for the institutions to upload the necessary information in the relevant part of the CINVU comprehensive system, which processes are available.

2- Professors can teach in the languages mentioned in this regulation.

Note: If the conditions are available, it is possible to teach in the native languages of the countries, according to the following guidelines.

3- Obtaining the CINVU international ID is mandatory for all professors of the member institutions, and the process of obtaining this ID will be done in cooperation with the institutions and the CINVU Education Committee.

4- Study opportunities are available in the form of virtual educational tours for professors in member countries by registering an application in the CINVU comprehensive system in the relevant section, and in-person tours will also be possible.

5- Intelligent teaching management system for professors of member institutions, according to declared indicators such as: The level of students' satisfaction with the professor, job creation and skill enhancement for students and other things can be effective in the promotion of professors' rank and related rewards whose system will be presented and completed over time.

6- The method of teaching, related tests, feedback on the level of education of the applicant and other matters related to this field will be available in the comprehensive system of CINVU and the relevant section.

7- Teaching fees and other matters related to professors' payments will be presented in the definitions of courses and sections and through the relevant systems.

8- Privileges for teachers' free training as well as private tutoring obtained through CINVU are unimpeded after the necessary notifications are made in compliance with the members' rights.

9- With the approval and support of CINVU and the cooperation of the member institutions, all relevant institutions in the countries will provide the necessary facilitation and assistance in the process of recruiting and exchanging professors.

10- The Ministerial Committee for Science and Technology of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (COMSTECH) will provide full support in the process of recruiting and exchanging professors, students, disciplines and resources, integration of documents and other related matters in cases of approval by the ministries of higher education, this support will be through the holding of COMSTECH annual general meetings and assemblies, effective correspondence with the ministries and other legal methods approved by the OIC.

D) Exchange of Subjects & Resources:

1- According to the scientific conditions and characteristics of member institutions and educational centers, it is possible to exchange some courses and resources that can be provided to other members.

2- Due to the fact that the privileges and rights created by this matter are considered exclusive or franchised for the institutions or higher education centers that provide it, other members who benefit from this matter shall have the above privilege from The entire income or tuition payment will work.

Note: In order to be a pioneer in doing this, it is recommended, this exclusive right be at his disposal as long as the said institution takes action to replace the resources in the new field and if new courses are not offered after being held in an educational period of at least 2 years, this right will automatically be terminated and in order not to lose the acquired rights within a period of 4 months, before the expiration, it will be notified to the relevant member of the matter.

3- The disciplines and resources needed by the members will be agreed upon in the meetings that will be held continuously by their representatives in the CINVU committees, and CINVU will enter if needed regarding the quality of the contents.

4- Uploading courses, resources in CINVU comprehensive system will be done in the relevant section.

5- The languages approved by CINVU are those mentioned in this regulation and constitution.

6- Postgraduate education approach, interdisciplinary studies, production of scientific contents with an international approach, understandable, appropriate to the common culture of Islamic

countries and religious commonalities, technological, production-oriented and product-oriented, it will be among the missions of the CINVU member institutions.

7- Obtaining the field and resource license will be according to the rules and regulations in the member countries; If needed, it is possible to create international courses and resources with the cooperation of the CINVU Education Committee, which after approval by all members, through the support of COMSTECH and also the members, the ministries of the countries, can be approved and implement it that the creation of these fields and resources will not be against the rules and regulations governing customs, culture and other important issues of the countries.

E) Integration of Documents & Certificates:

1- In order to make optimal use of educational capacities and resources, the integration of documents and certificates of member institutions will be implemented for students who have completed their studies in CINVU member institutions at the undergraduate, graduate and doctoral levels, so that the applicants can continue their studies in a virtual and hybrid way, according to their interests, in bachelor's, master's and doctorate degrees without complex and difficult processes of validation and evaluation of documents and certificates by countries and institutions.

2- All applicants who wish to have accredited documents with different grades will participate in the test that is periodically conducted by the destination university in the comprehensive system of CINVU for courses or fields and after confirming the completion of the degree by the source institution and CINVU (CINVU international authenticity code), the destination institution will accept the student without re-validation and evaluation.

3- All members will accept documents and certificates issued by each other without any obstacles after CINVU approval that the regulatory processes for these matters will be developed and implemented in the legal frameworks for each institution, and this acceptance will not interfere with the regulations related to educational courses in academic levels with short-term educational courses.

4- The information related to all the graduates of the member institutions will be uploaded in the CINVU comprehensive system and in the relevant section to confirm the authenticity so that, while receiving the relevant code, the applicants who intend to continue their education in different member countries, can proceed with the registration to recruitment and training processes.

5- By carrying out information loading processes in the CINVU comprehensive system, in an intelligent way, all the graduates of the education levels and courses have their information registered and accessible in the CINVU comprehensive system as well as other member institutions and the integration of documents will be definitely achieved.

Note: Regarding the integration process, the regulations related to universities and the relevant ministry are given priority, and if necessary, the regulations related to CINVU cooperation, in the cases attached to this regulation, should be amended. and will be updated.

F) Ranking of Institutions:

1- It will be possible to rank institutions based on the following indicators:

- hardware and software resources and infrastructure;
- Internal/foreign student acceptance capacity;
- Number of study fields/educational groups;
- The history and brilliant background of higher education activities;
- Academic level and ranks of the members of the academic staff working in an official/contractual/teaching capacity;
- Having domestic and foreign agencies and branches;
- Type of academic/ governmental/public/private ownership;
- Infrastructure facilities and physical infrastructure;
- The existence of organizations and units related to higher education centers in the form of legal and real / research / service organizations / knowledge-based companies based on production / publishing and intellectual property;
- Facilities and development plans for medium and long-term programs of the higher education center and its phased realization;
- Conducting research activities in different courses, including applied/fundamental/knowledge-based and its effectiveness in theses in order to improve the quality and quantity of research activities;
- Effective cultural activities in improving the level of cultural, social, poverty alleviation, development oriented cooperation;
- Activities related to the commercialization of knowledge and technology;
- The amount of transactions based on the export of products with the highest standard in Islamic countries and other countries.

2- This ranking will start after the approval of the regulations by the CINVU education committee and with the cooperation of the members.

3- The ranking is updated every two years.

4- The portal related to the ranking of institutions will be activated in the CINVU comprehensive system.

5- The points of this ranking for different institutions will be prepared later and its results will be visible for the top institutions in different formats.

G) Implementation of Educational Cooperation of Members:

1- The Secretary General of CINVU will issue appointments rules to all the members of the Education Committee of the CINVU Strategic Council and other influential people in this field, including heads and assistants of education of institutions, influential scientific, executive and legal personalities in the Islamic world and other people who they can play a role in advancing these matters, they can be among its main members.

2- Financial discussions and payments of committee members and executive directors will be possible within CINVU frameworks.

3- Other duties of the said committee will be implemented gradually with the cooperation of the members.

4- Completing all processes related to training courses, exchange of students, professors, fields and resources, integration of documents, ratings and other required items within 6 months from the date of approval of the regulations in the CINVU comprehensive system, with the cooperation of all members, it is possible to the permanent secretariat and CINVU committees, in case of cooperation of all members, undertake to carry out processes and provide related infrastructures with the cooperation of knowledge-based institutions and companies of their understanding;

5- Secretaries and members of some committees whose appointments were previously issued by the Secretary General of CINVU, their activities will be valid according to the announced appointments, as long as the Secretary General has not given them a new notification.



Part 3)

Research Collaborations



Introduction:

Research collaborations are possible in different formats between members, which will be mentioned separately according to the type of collaboration;

The main goal of this cooperation is to identify the capacities of the members, synergize and carry out joint research projects in a virtual and combined manner so that the level of research activities in all dimensions has increased significantly and be effective in realizing justice in the field of research and development in an intelligent manner in the Islamic world.

A) Treatises, Theses & Articles:

1- The member institutions can benefit from scientific, research and educational facilities with the participation of each other that among them, defining and carrying out dissertations and joint articles with problem-oriented approaches, responding to operational needs in various fields of science, especially laying the groundwork for the advancement of technology in Islamic countries.

2- The desired titles in the field of research collaborations are uploaded by the member institutions in the comprehensive system of CINVU in the relevant section so that the applicants, knowing the capacities of other centers, can carry out the dissertation work in other member institutions in the form of to hold jointly.

3- The acquired rights resulting from doing joint work in the form of quantity and quality presented in theses and treatise are reserved for the trustees and institutions that are not able to carry out some research topics in this field can use the capacity of other institutions by announcing institutions in the CINVU comprehensive system, applicants including professors, researchers, students and faculty members can benefit from this capacity.

4- The CINVU research committee defines the working procedure and the exclusive or common right of member institutions active in this field with the cooperation of institutions that the acquired right can be presented and approved as a gift, or it can be granted within the framework of the balance of incentive points and rank promotion.

5- All executive affairs related to research collaborations are carried out in coordination with the research committee and the permanent secretariat of CINVU that the quality of contracts and the way of spiritual and financial contributions will be defined for each project.

6- The description of the duties of CINVU research committee is as follows:

- 6-1- Evaluation of the current state of research, especially in virtual form in the Islamic world, and studies regarding achieving the desired state of this field;
- 6-2- Examining, analyzing and diagnosing the processes of doing work and making suggestions in order to improve the efficiency of research and achieve the desired state of research in the Islamic world;
- 6-3- Preparing and compiling policies, suitable strategies and practical methods in order to improve the performance and increase the quality of projects and researches;
- 6-4- Identifying countries and universities that benefit less from research and its achievements and helping to strengthen them;
- 6-5- Examining and suggesting completion and modification of operating instructions, technical specifications, criteria and standards used in the field of research;
- 6-6- Determining the priority and defining the titles of research projects and commenting on ways to use new technologies in the study and implementation of projects and announcing the points of view for future research;
- 6-7- Giving priority to innovation in the theoretical field and applied and strategic research needed by CINVU and the Islamic world;
- 8-6- Developing, strengthening and directing approved research projects with priority of targeted applied research based on vision documents, development programs and comprehensive scientific maps of countries;
- 6-9- Large-scale coordination in holding scientific seminars and conferences, review seats and the implementation of all matters of research and service contracts and related memorandums of understanding between virtual universities of Islamic countries and other networks, as well as management of study opportunities for CINVU elites;
- 6-10- Supporting the supply and production of digital content in the digital library system of member institutions along with the creation of a comprehensive database of top research professors, research activities, ongoing and completed projects in the fields of Quranic knowledge, medicine Islamic and traditional, medicine, natural energy and other priority needs of the Islamic world;
- 6-11- Effort to form and support scientific associations, entrepreneurship and elites of professors and students and establishment of desirable interdisciplinary applied courses in member institutions;

6-12- Designing a comprehensive system for the influence of academic faculty members of virtual universities in the production of science and printing and management of publications of scientific journals, scientific productions, (scientific, research and promotional articles, national and international conferences, authorship) and poetry, book reviews, scientific, cultural, artistic festivals in digital form, etc).

7- The members use the scientific and professional potentials of the professors with international ID for scientific and research matters, which related instruments are defined.

8- Organizing articles and theses and directing the production of value in Islamic societies will be among the priorities of members' cooperation in the field of research.

9- Privilege system, research support and intellectual property rights will be provided through CINVU research committee and with the participation of members.

10- Ranking of articles, printing, credit and other issues related to this field, through the created reliable citation databases such as SCImago, Publons, ISC, QS, Shanghai, Times, Leiden and CINVU's own articles database will be possible according to the communicated instructions, and the member institutions will approve all the articles published in this field.

B) Knowledge-based and Mission-Oriented Projects:

1- The participation of members in formulating and presenting knowledge-based and mission-oriented projects as one of the most central areas of interaction and synergistic capacity of members, which plays a significant role in realizing the justice of science and technology in the Islamic world it will be possible through the CINVU research committee, according to the standards defined in the comprehensive system.

2- Knowledge-based plans are plans that it has a decisive role in the gross production in Islamic countries, creating scientific and technological competition, stable employment, increasing wealth, developing industry and other requirements for the growth of knowledge in the Islamic world and its mission orientation will also be visible quantitatively in annual, three-year, seven-year and ten-year plans.

3- The member institutions, in cooperation with each other, especially the research committee, put on the agenda from formulation to support in the implementation of projects and at least in each country that has an active member in CINVU, 5 mega projects per year according to needs assessment and prioritization. They should do that based on the type of specialized, scientific and executive trends, the required validation and its effectiveness are included in

various activities, and as the case may be, the necessary action is taken by determining the real and legal participating groups and setting up cooperation agreements.

4- In the cooperation agreements and determining the credits for these activities, CINVU's share of the credits allocated for this purpose is at an agreed percentage to cover the expenses of related committees and projects.

5- The international credit of CINVU for all the resulting plans and projects is a rich support for moving things forward all relevant institutions and organizations in the countries, they should support their titles and implementation and this credit should be approved by members and countries.

C) Management of Standardization of Contents & Texts & Translation Movement:

1- Basic texts or contents that are used in various fields of humanities, technical engineering, art and medical sciences, through their standardization, they help to promote education and research in Islamic countries for effectiveness and information exchange.

2- Through the comprehensive system of CINVU and the relevant part, the content standardization indicators will be accessible by the research committee in cooperation with the members and the CINVU secretariat.

3- Titles that can be translated to realize the translation movement and unify the method of presenting contents for countries in various statistical sciences and subsequently in the calendar of research activities of publishing members and according to the agreement of the content owners and the translators through an agreement that is drawn up and It is exchanged.

4- To standardize contents and texts and translate them into the main languages of CINVU.

5- Acquired rights for contents will be reserved within legal frameworks.

6- In order to validate and spread the activities related to this field as much as possible, a percentage of the sales of publications, contents and books will be at the disposal of the CINVU Permanent Secretariat to be able to provide the necessary capacity building to carry out long-term and effective work as much as possible, the amount of which will be included in the agreement.

7- Setting up research institutes and virtual research institutes as well as smart research and development centers are among the joint actions of CINVU research committee and member institutions issuing its licenses is the responsibility of the CINVU Research Committee, and the

validity of this research institute, research and development centers in all countries and member institutions is definitive.

8- Production of scientific, educational, research, multimedia contents, smart libraries, structuring of research groups and other research requirements, including the outputs of research institutes and research and development centers, which the process of recruiting researchers, professors, students, associate members and faculty members will be developed by them in the next executive frameworks, which will be approved by CINVU and member institutions.

9- Knowledge-based companies that are members of CINVU, as well as knowledge-based companies affiliated with member institutions, the rulings of CINVU institutions apply to them, and maximum utilization of their capacity is on the agenda of the Islamic world.

10- In the processes related to the translation movement, the use of the capacities of translation groups and language training between member institutions will be fully implemented and the ability of each group of institutions is provided to the other group.

D) Holding Webinars & Scientific Conferences & Developing New Technologies:

1- It is possible to design and compile any webinars and international scientific conferences between members through registration in the comprehensive system of CINVU, in the relevant section.

2- The portal created in the system has a participatory and directional approach in all educational, research, cultural, financial and other required areas, and the main implementers of these programs are member institutions and centers.

3- The points of conference articles will be according to the rules of scientific organization, and the international validity of these events is a definite thing that is approved by all member countries and institutions.

4- Creating technology in the field of research has privileges for member institutions, which it will have an impact on the rankings of institutions and special support from CINVU will be provided in their commercialization.

5- Indexing to create new technologies through research and turning them into large and applicable projects in Islamic countries, including important measures in research collaborations and new technologies with an approach to environmental health, energy It is pure and new and based on Islamic sciences and knowledge that is emphasized.

6- The information bank of all the researchers, personalities, articles and theses that are highly cited and useful will be prepared by the member institutions in cooperation with the CINVU research committee and will be uploaded in the comprehensive system, so that all applicants can benefit from their information capacity.

7- All other research activities and cooperation with other COMSTECH networks will be defined and implemented in cooperation with CINVU Research Committee and member institutions.

E) Implementation of Members' Research Collaborations:

1- The Secretary General of CINVU will issue appointments to all the members of the Research Committee of the CINVU Strategic Council and other influential people in this field that heads and research assistants of institutions, influential scientific, executive and legal figures in the Islamic world and other people who can play a role in advancing these matters can be among its main members.

2- Financial discussions and payments of committee members and executive directors will be possible within CINVU frameworks.

3- Other duties of the said committee will be implemented gradually with the cooperation of the members.

4- It is possible to complete all the processes related to research cooperation according to the presented titles within 6 months from the date of approval of the regulations in the CINVU comprehensive system with the cooperation of all members that the permanent secretariat and CINVU committees, in case of cooperation of all members, undertake to carry out processes and provide related infrastructures with the cooperation of knowledge-based institutions and companies of their mutual understanding.

5- Secretaries and members of some committees whose appointments were previously issued by the Secretary General of CINVU, their activities will be valid according to the announced appointments, as long as the Secretary General has not given them a new notification.

Introduction:

Improving the level of culture and social integration of the Islamic Ummah depends on cultural and social cooperation, student movements, associations, festivals, competitions, Olympiads and other events that CINVU considers it necessary to create cultural, Quranic, social and student cooperation among its members as a leading elite society in the Islamic world based on Islamic values.

A) Knowing the cultures of nations and agreed upon cultural patterns and implementing other related programs:

1- In order to get to know the culture and customs of Islamic countries, personalities, scientific and cultural luminaries, activists in the field of science and technology and other fields and in order to facilitate the processes of knowledge and technology transfer, the member institutions will upload a booklet introducing the capabilities of each institution in the comprehensive CINVU system.

2- On a continuous basis, they organize training courses on the culture of Islamic nations, the ways of discourse of integration and unity, centered on the holy book of the Holy Quran, in cooperation with each other.

3- The indicators of holding courses and also the main cultural cooperation of students will be compiled and implemented by the cultural committee of CINVU with the participation of member institutions.

4- All executive matters related to cultural cooperation are done with the coordination of the cultural committee and the permanent secretariat of CINVU, and the quality of the activities and the way of spiritual and financial contributions will be defined for each project.

5- The description of the duties of the CINVU cultural committee is as follows:

5-1- Draw the current and desired situation (identification, study, feasibility) of this area and determining the policies, instructions and strategic policies of the field, cultural, Quranic, social and students of virtual universities in Islamic countries;

5-2- Carrying out strategic studies regarding the quality of identifying elites and Quranic thinkers and planning and organizing under the systems and start-ups in order to train Quranic forces, managers and capable for effective presence in the national and international arenas;

5-3- To strengthen think-tank organizations to produce plans and programs and obtain strategies from the Holy Quran in order to define and carry out large-scale projects in various fields of knowledge and their implementation;

5-4- Guiding and supervising cultural, Quranic, student and social affairs of the network and a special definition of the position of this area in influencing other networks in accordance with the relevant approvals, regulations and by-laws and with the cooperation of other relevant institutions;

5-5- Paying attention to promoting the culture of dialogue, methodical criticism of science, Freereviews of science and expanding the field of communication between academicians and experts in scientific, Quranic, cultural and social opinion with other networks and creating a platform for continuous interaction of academics inside and outside the network with other networks, member countries and other countries of the world;

5-6- Planning for the development of Quranic, cultural, social and moral education through holding educational classes and webinars;

5-7- Setting up and managing the virtual online counseling process for students and other members of the academics of the virtual network and other networks using the most up-to-date systems;

8-5- Planning appreciation of professors, students, managers and other cultural, Quranic and social activists of member institutions;

5-9- Continuous communication with Islamic organizations and social and Quranic centers of students in order to provide material and spiritual support for their useful and constructive activities;

5-10- Examining the norms, challenges, injuries, religious doubts and social cultural crises governing the academic society and compiling and presenting strategic plans to deal with them and also providing a special program in the field of health management, welfare, facilities, marriage, recognition of elites, Hajj affairs, etc for students of virtual universities in Islamic countries;

5-11- Studying, planning and follow-up to create suitable electronic platforms for the flourishing of artistic, literary, technological talents, personal and social skills of students and creating the necessary facilities for the active participation of students in events, cultural, literary and artistic sections of the festival and other religious ceremonies, etc at different levels;

5-12- Designing targeted courses of strategic management in the cultural, social and Quranic fields and continuous monitoring of the good implementation of its various stages in the network and other networks.

6- Cultural, social and student courses and collaborations are carried out in full respect for ethnic and religious beliefs and with the coordination of CINVU cultural committee, permanent secretariat and organizing institutions.

7- The content of courses and cultural patterns will be approved by CINVU's cultural committee.

8- The platform for holding courses is virtual and in some cases in the form of cultural tours.

9- Student services, facilities, discounts, support and other related matters are done with the coordination and cooperation of institutions and cultural committee.

10- Conducting comprehensive counseling for the students of member institutions through the CINVU comprehensive system is done in the relevant part with the coordination of the institutions in different fields with the use of experts in each field.

11- Meetings related to cultural, student and social activities will be held continuously with the cooperation of the cultural committee and institutions and with the requests of students according to specific processes.

12- Holding these courses and joint collaborations will help to improve the cultural level in Islamic countries with the cooperation of institutions and international culturally active institutions in Islamic countries, and these activities will be approved by them.

Note: It is possible to create a specialized committee in the field of the sciences and teachings of the Holy Quran or a similar center or unit, with the approval of the members of the committee and the secretary general, if a reasonable structure is presented.

B) Freereviews Seats of Criticism & Theories:

1- The CINVU comprehensive system will allocate a special section for each Freereviews course so that after producing the content and coordination necessary for holding them and determining the topic, it will be held.

2- In the end, the meetings are held with mutual respect and without expressing any tension-causing expressions from the point of view of literature.

3- The supervisor and moderator of holding the Freereviews Seat will be introduced later according to the plan of the seat.

4- CINVU virtual platform will host these discussions in compliance with international standards.

5- The output and results of these courses will be exposed to the public, especially students, in the form of effective content to encourage others to express their opinions, doubts and scientific, cultural, Quranic, economic, artistic, literary, technological and other issues and to promote the culture of free criticism in all Islamic societies and the Islamic world as a whole.

6- Literary, artistic, student organizations and other subjects needed by the Islamic world can receive necessary permits in the international arena through the cultural committee.

7- CINVU and its member institutions declare their support for all cultural activities that help to increase the level of individual and social awareness of Islamic countries in recognizing friend and enemy.

8- Other related programs are carried out with the coordination of CINVU cultural committee.

C) Festivals, Competitions, Olympiads and CINVU Awards:

1- It is possible to hold festivals, competitions, Olympiads and awards with the cooperation of the CINVU cultural committee and member institutions by defining indicators and events that have international validity.

2- The quality of holding these events by the CINVU cultural committee and it will be presented through the comprehensive system and the relevant section and the member institutions will have the utmost cooperation in holding it.

3- In the processes of getting feedback from holding events, it is important to realize the indicators of increasing morale, effectiveness, vitality, self-confidence, respect for competitors, cooperation and interaction and member institutions and CINVU's cultural committee will continuously monitor the holding of these events.

4- Each member institution will organize two virtual or combined international events annually with the participation of other members and this joint event, if all institutions participate in it, will be close to achieving the respective goals.

5- Dissemination of Islamic culture in the countries will be one of the important outputs of these events, and the elite and student society will fulfill its mission in promoting the culture of

cooperation, peace, security, struggle in the way of Allah, Khums, Zakat and other Islamic principles with the cooperation of member institutions. and CINVU, will do.

D) Implementation of Cultural, Quranic, Social & Student Collaborations:

1- The Secretary General of CINVU will issue appointments to all members of the Cultural Committee of the CINVU Strategic Council and other influential people in this field that the presidents and vice-presidents of cultural, social and student institutions, influential scientific, executive and legal figures in the Islamic world and other people who can play a role in advancing these matters can be among its main members.

2- Financial discussions and payments of committee members and executive directors will be possible within CINVU frameworks.

3- Other duties of the said committee will be implemented gradually with the cooperation of the members.

4- It is possible to complete all the processes related to cultural cooperation according to the presented titles within 6 months from the date of approval of the regulations in the CINVU comprehensive system with the cooperation of all members that the permanent secretariat and CINVU committees, in case of cooperation of all members, undertake to carry out processes and provide related infrastructures with the cooperation of knowledge-based institutions and companies of their mutual understanding.

5- Secretaries and members of some committees whose appointments were previously issued by the Secretary General of CINVU, their activities will be valid according to the announced appointments, as long as the Secretary General has not given them a new notification.

Part 5)

Economic Cooperation Based on Commercialization of Knowledge, Technology & Knowledge-Based Products

Introduction:

All educational, research, cultural, social and generally scientific and technological activities will not guarantee the authority of countries and their future until they result in the creation of added value in Islamic societies one of the important missions of CINVU is to create connections between members and, as a result, facilitate the creation of achievements and their introduction to countries to exploit the capacities and capabilities of scientific and technological institutions and, as a result, the public bodies of countries that in this section, important financial cooperation solutions and other strategic-executive cooperation resulting in the output will be mentioned in detail.

A) Members' Strategic Information & Communication Bank:

1- All the capabilities available in the institutions with the aim of creating added value in the countries will be presented in the form of a network information and communication bank with the cooperation of all the member institutions, the economic committee and the permanent secretariat of CINVU.

2- This information and communication bank will be exposed to all members in the comprehensive CINVU system and in the relevant section.

3- All executive matters related to economic cooperation and commercialization of knowledge are carried out in cooperation with the economic committee and permanent secretariat of CINVU and member institutions.

4- The description of the duties of CINVU Economic Committee is as follows:

4-1- Drawing the current and desired situation (identification, study, feasibility) of this field and determining the policies, instructions and strategic policies of providing capital with the Islamic financing model for CINVU activities in line with the mission of commercialization;

2-4- Strategic-operational planning in order to provide capital through the member countries, comprehensive analysis of resources, communication with the Islamic Development Bank, international assemblies and other custodian and Islamic financier institutions for the exploitation of CINVU members and the model Creating for other networks in the field of financing in various fields of science, technology, economy, culture, agriculture, medicine, law, human and technical knowledge, industries, mines, petrochemical, IT, medicinal plants, etc;

4-3- Planning for the provision of physical facilities (tools, data centers, IT facilities, personnel, provision of start-up costs, etc.) of the network in order to develop and expand the required

educational spaces and take action regarding the provision of construction credit CINVU requirement;

4-4- Coordinating for the management of allocated credits to member institutions and other units in cooperation with the CINVU Permanent Secretariat according to CINVU's financial regulations and providing the necessary proposals in related fields to the Secretary General;

4-5- Preparing, compiling and indexing financial reports based on international economic cooperation and creating a comprehensive database of all documents and submitting it to the secretariat;

4-6- Providing advice on drawing the current and desirable state of the network with the approach of commercializing technology and knowledge in various fields of virtual universities in Islamic countries;

4-7- Cooperation with the CINVU permanent secretariat in matters related to personnel organization in the field of financial documents, payments, missions, contracts, rights, facilities, selection, strategic council committees and other administrative and financial requirements;

4-8- Cooperation and participation in preparing and compiling strategic and operational plans of CINVU and member institutions and presenting comprehensive plans in the field of transformation of management and resources and large income generation for CINVU;

4-9- Providing advice regarding feasibility, business plans, analysis of the existing situation and other requirements for the coordination of components for business plans;

4-10- Initial proposal of the text of contracts, agreements, declarations and agreements related to the economic field and commercialization of knowledge and smart technology;

4-11- Performing operational SWOT analysis for all plans related to CINVU and other networks and communications with member countries and other countries of the world.

5- Implementation of financial affairs according to the statutes is done through the Secretary General and with his approval.

6- All member institutions will upload the method of benefiting from the economic capacities in the form of a proposal or preliminary plan in the CINVU comprehensive system in the relevant section.

7- The contribution amount of each member will be mentioned according to the type of activity in each project in the form of a meeting minutes, contract, letter or any other legal way.

8- Members' participation can be considered financially or benefiting from organizational capacity, human resources, infrastructure and other related matters that have economic value for cooperation.

9- The percentage of providing CINVU services from each transaction or financial action will be determined proportionately.

10- CINVU and COMSTECH with continuous and effective correspondence, to attract credits and also facilities from aligned and related international organizations such as COMCEC, IDB and other organizations fully support the activities of the committee and member institutions.

11- Processes related to the commercialization of knowledge and knowledge-based products will be compiled and presented by the economic committee and members.

12- The member institutions will have full cooperation with the economic committee and other departments.

B) The Method of Interactions & Financial Exchanges of Members in the Commercialization of Knowledge & Products:

1- It will be possible to establish a credit institution in one of the member countries in order to carry out financial exchanges through digital currencies after the infrastructure related to this field is provided with the cooperation of the economic committee and member institutions through the permanent secretariat that carrying out this process prevents losses caused by currency fluctuations and changes in the floating rate of the monetary bases of countries.

2- Due to the expansion of exchanges, it is possible to proceed with the establishment of a bank in the form of the economic committee of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation by going through the relevant processes.

3- A digital currency with scientific and technological support will be introduced by the economic committee to carry out exchanges and transactions, and this currency is approved and accepted by all members.

4- The creation of an international virtual store of science and technology in the Islamic world in order to introduce and sell knowledge-based products is placed on the agenda of the economic committee and member institutions of CINVU and considering that these exchanges and transactions take place on the platform of CINVU, a percentage of the sales of the products will be assigned to this organization, which will be agreed upon.

5- This store will have international reputation in the Islamic world, especially the 57 Islamic countries that are members of the OIC.

6- Inventions and innovations made by member institutions and knowledge-based companies affiliated with the institutions and also member knowledge-based companies of CINVU, in the virtual store section of the CINVU comprehensive system and it will be defined exclusively for inventors and innovators with respect to intellectual and material property rights.

7- The creation of an innovation and inventions fund, if needed, can be established to provide special support to innovative activists in the Islamic world.

8- Attracting investors for all projects and innovations is on the joint agenda of the economic committee and member institutions.

9- The quality of implementation of information processes, capital attraction, economic justification plan, feasibility and transformation into a project will be compiled by the economic committee and member institutions.

C) Implementation of Economic Cooperation Based on Commercialization of Knowledge, Technology & Knowledge-Based Products:

1- The Secretary General of CINVU will issue appointments to all members of the Economic Committee of the Strategic Council of CINVU and other influential people in this field that heads and administrative and financial assistants of institutions, economic consultants, heads of knowledge-based companies affiliated with member institutions or direct members of CINVU, influential scientific, executive and legal figures in the Islamic world and other people who can advance these matters. play a role, they can be among its main members.

2- Financial discussions and payments of committee members and executive directors will be possible within CINVU frameworks.

3- Other duties of the said committee will be implemented gradually with the cooperation of the members.

4- It is possible to complete all the processes related to economic cooperation according to the presented titles within 6 months from the date of approval of the regulations in the CINVU comprehensive system with the cooperation of all members that the permanent secretariat and CINVU committees, in case of cooperation of all members, undertake to carry out processes and provide related infrastructures with the cooperation of knowledge-based institutions and companies of their mutual understanding.

5- Secretaries and members of some committees whose appointments were previously issued by the Secretary General of CINVU, their activities will be valid according to the announced appointments, as long as the Secretary General has not given them a new notification.

D) Other Strategic-Executive Cooperation:

1- Other related cooperation with CINVU members, within the framework of other council committees such as:

- Media cooperation;
- Cooperation between start-ups and knowledge-based companies;
- IT Committee;
- Progress structure;
- Quranic sciences and knowledge;
- Medical education, health and treatment.

And other committees that will be necessary for the activities are possible that according to the formation of the relevant committees, cooperation is carried out.

2- To carry out any cooperation between member institutions and CINVU, a cooperation request registration portal will be created between members to be intelligently referred to the relevant committee for cooperation between members and to carry out processes through correspondence.

3- The CINVU automation system, under the title of CCMS, was created as an integrated portal for conducting correspondence and follow-ups related to the implementation of affairs so that members can establish strategic and executive communication intelligently under the supervision of CINVU.

4- Other matters that are not mentioned in this regulation and will need to be presented as an attachment in order to enrich and complete this document subsequently, as an inseparable attachment, this regulation will be compiled, presented and implemented with the participation of the members.

5- CINVU's permanent secretariat will always respond to questions and doubts and accept suggestions and criticisms to improve processes and advance CINVU's and members' goals and plans.
